The Clock Has Run Out! Time To Speak Up! We Aim to End Violence Against Women

El Paso, Texas-October 4, 2018. Karina Yapor left her home at age 12 carrying her bible and school bag to take music lessons from then famous rock star Gloria Trevi. In her book *Revelaciones* Yapor reveals her bitter experiences with Trevi, her manager Sergio Andrade and Mary Boquitas giving a shocking and candid account of the Mexican Star’s real-life experiences as the victim of mental and sexual abuse. Yapor will give her testimonial at Wise Latina International’s Annual Summit “Enough is Enough! Ya Basta!” on Saturday, October 6, 2018 at El Paso Community College, 9050 Viscount, ASC, Building A slated to take place from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The summit aims to address the escalating violence against women.

Wise Latina is partnering with El Paso County Attorney’s Office, Trial Team Chief Protective Order Unit, Selina Saenz; District Attorney’s Domestic Violence Unit Chief, Patricia Baca; University of Texas at El Paso’s Women & Gender Studies; El Paso Community College; Center Against Sex and Family Violence, and media partner News Channel 9 KTSM in an effort to build leadership alliances to tackle and put a stop to sexual harassment, assault, and domestic violence. 1 in 4 and 1 in 9 men experience sexual, physical violence and or stalking by an intimate partner. 23% of female victims first experience physical violence or stalking before their 18th birthday.

UTEP Professors, Drs. Gina Nunez and Lucia Dura will lead the breakout sessions using liberating structures in order to provide a safe place to discover, unleash, and generate local solutions to the problems around stigma, fear, and silence in situations of sexual harassment, assault, and domestic violence. A plenary *Defining & Asserting Your Rights* will include attorneys Saenz, Baca and sexual harassment attorney Roger Davie. Joining them will be Jessica Ugarte, advocate Criminal Victim Compensation certified victim services provider. Denise Chavez Author/Director, Casa Camino Real, Las Cruces, New Mexico will be reading from her novel “*Street of Too Many Stories*,” centering on a legacy of dysfunction, alcoholism, neglect and abuse. The Summit will conclude with laugh energy work *Laughter of the Soul/La Risa del Alma* led by Reiki Master/Therapist Alma Calderon. Certified counseling will be available onsite.
